Did You Know

- The corridors throughout the state are vital to economic stability and growth. Each year nearly \$600 Billion in freight is moved on Michigan's roadways.
- Approximately 1.9 million fulltime jobs in Michigan in key industries like tourism, retail sales, agriculture and manufacturing are completely dependent on the state's transportation network.
- TRIP, a national transportation research group found that transportation investment has a return of over 5 to 1.
- 87% of goods shipped in the U.S. are carried on highways.¹
