
# **AAA's ERS Operations**

- Nationwide AAA services 32 million road service events yearly
- AAA Michigan Operations
  - Over 200 hundred ERS providers

 Grand Rapids Fleet has 14 trucks, 14 drivers, expected to service about 10,000-15,000 calls a year

 AAA Michigan services approximately 1 million events yearly

- 40% tow events
- 25% battery-related events





### **ERS Statistics**

- One tow operator is killed every other week in the line of duty
- Tow operators have one of the most dangerous jobs in the United States
  - 15x more deadly than all private industries combined
- 2020 total roadside fatalities reported = 46
  - Roadside fatalities are grouped by the type of job; Fire/EMS,
     Police, Mobile Mechanics, etc.
  - Tow drivers sustained 21 of these roadside fatalities, representing 45% of all fatalities reported
- Tow operators have continued to provide essential services during the COVID-19 pandemic



- Stronger Distracted Driving Laws in Michigan
- Consumer awareness and education on the Slow Down Move Over Law
- Enforcement of the Slow Down Move Over Law



Jan. 26, 2021 – 14 people died on Michigan roadways since last week making a total of 43 this year. In addition, 60 more were seriously injured for a statewide total of 160 to date.

Compared to last year at this time there are 3 more fatalities and 12 fewer serious injuries.
