Thursday, August 19, 2021

The House Committee on Workforce, Trades, and Talent was called to order by the Chair.

The Chair laid HB 5115 before the committee:

HB 5115 (Rep. Yaroch)

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code," by amending section 20950 (MCL 333.20950), as amended by 2021 PA 25.

Representative Eisen moved to adopt the meeting minutes from June 24, 2021. There being no objections, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

A bill to prohibit employers from discriminating against an individual because the individual has not received or declines to receive certain vaccinations; to prohibit retaliation; and to provide remedies.
