The House Committee on Appropriations Subcommittee on Judiciary was called to order by the Chair, Representative Lightner.

He discussed FY 2021-22 budget priorities, the Public Defender Division, overturning wrongful convictions, human and financial costs of sentencing errors, and the Juvenile Lifer Unit.

Marilena David-Martin, Deputy Director, State Appellate Defender Office, appeared before the subcommittee to discuss the impact of COVID-19 on SADO's client caseload, SADO's continued advocacy during the pandemic, the Criminal Defense Resource Center, and Project Reentry. Questions and answers followed.
