## Beyond the Orchard

## An Important Industry Cluster



Michigan's food \& agribusiness industry employs $17 \%$ of the state's total manufacturing employment


Farm work compromises only $30 \%$ of all employment opportunities in the ag industry, meaning 70\% of ag-related jobs are outside of farms \& orchards

The food \& agribusiness industry is the $2^{\text {nd }}$ largest industry in the state
