



### **Avian Influenza**


HPAI depopulations continue to disrupt egg and turkey production as confirmations persisted beyond midyear, unlike what occurred in the 2014-15 outbreak, when instances ceased in June

In December alone, 3.7 million layers were depopulated across 3 states

For reference, during the 2014/15 outbreak 43 million layers were lost



### **Prices to consumers recovering from last year**




# **History on Al Vaccine**

- Influenza Vaccines are not allowed to be used in poultry production due to trade implications
- The virus is carried and spread typically by waterfowl (migration)
- Primary measures to deal with high path avian influenza (HPAI) have been biosecurity to prevent
- The goal is to "stamp-out" the virus by culling flocks that are infected (Whole complexes in layer systems)




Non-Organic Table Egg Layer Flock in millions of hens
