COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Tuesday, September 19, 9:00 Room 352, House Appropriations, State Capitol 2023 AM Building

The House Committee on Criminal Justice was called to order by Chair Hope.

HB 4641 (Rep. Arbit)

and adoption services act," by amending sections 5, 8a, 8b, and 8d (MCL 722.955, 722.958a, 722.958b, and 722.958d), section 8a as added by 2014 PA 524, section 8b as added by 2018 PA 489,

and section 8d as added by 2018 PA 632.
