## **COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

The House Committee on Education was called to order by Chair Koleszar.

The Chair laid SB 161 and SB 162 before the committee:

SB 161 (Sen. Geiss) A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The

revised school code," by amending sections 1526, 1531, 1531d, 1531j, and 1531k (MCL 380.1526, 380.1531, 380.1531d, 380.1531j, and 380.1531k), section 1526 as amended by 1995 PA 289, section 1531 as amended by 2018 PA 235, section 1531d as added by 2003 PA 18, and sections 1531j and

1531k as amended by 2018 PA 234.

SB 162 (Sen. McCann) A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The

revised school code," by amending section 1233 (MCL 380.1233), as amended by 2021 PA 149.
