COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Tuesday, June 20, 9:00 Room 352, House Appropriations, State Capitol 2023 AM Building

The House Committee on Education was called to order by Chair Koleszar.

The Committee was meeting jointly with the Senate Education Committee.

Representative Churches moved to adopt the meeting minutes from June 13, 2023. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid HB 4820 before the committee:

HB 4820 (Rep. Skaggs) A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The

revised school code," by amending section 1248 (MCL 380.1248), as added by 2011 PA 102.

At 9:04 AM, the Chair laid the committee at ease.

At 9:06 AM, the Chair called the committee back to order.

SB 359 (Sen. Chang)

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code," by amending section 1250 (MCL 380.1250), as amended by 2018 PA 601.

Senator Chang testified in support of SB 359. Questions and discussion followed.

A bill to amend 2020 PA 366, entitled "An act to prohibit postsecondary educational institutions in this state and certain athletic organizations from preventing a college athlete from receiving compensation for the use of his or her name, image, or likeness rights," by amending section 10 (MCL 390.1740).

Representative Weiss moved to refer HB 4319 to the Committee on Higher Education. The motion prevailed 14-0-0:
