



### Vulnerable Adults in foster care facilities are already a legally "protected class"


- This legislation does not change the existing law's definition.
- See MCL 750.145m (1994).






### Chronological age ≠ cognitive / mental age



- Inability to recognize a dangerous situation






### Greatest vulnerability for:
