




Three Things to Remember About PBMs

- 1. PBMs are the only entity in the drug supply chain dedicated to seeking lower costs
- 2. No one is mandated to use a PBM
- 3. PBMs account for 6 cents of the dollar spend on prescription drugs

What PBMs DO and DON'T DO

DC

- PBMs provide lower costs for X Set the list price of drugs prescription drugs.
- PBMs administer the prescription drug portion of the health care benefit for employers and customers
- PBMs perform a variety of services to ensure highquality, cost-efficient delivery of prescription drugs to consumers

DON'T DO

- X Allow you to take drugs that will be harmful or negatively interact with other drugs
- X Allow you to take a drug for the wrong reason




Some combination of the following options include:

- 3. Administrative Fee



PBMs help save patients and payers 40-50% on their annual drug and related medical costs compared to what they would have spent without PBMs.

Improve Health Care Quality and Patient Outcomes

- Reduce medication errors through use of drug utilization review programs.
 - Over next 10 years, PBMs will help prevent
 1 billion medication errors.
 - Improve drug therapy and patient adherence, notably in the areas of diabetes and multiple sclerosis.
- Manage programs to address opioid use issues.

PBM savings

PBMs are projected to save employers, unions, government programs, and consumers an average of \$1,040 per person per year.

PBMs Gross Margin \$6¹ Costs Would Be More Than \$60 Higher Without PBMs ²


The ROI on PBM Services Equals More Than 10:1



A UHG study of PBM's in Managed Medicaid (e.g., 2019 savings of \$8.5 billion, offset by PBM fees of only \$430 million) calculated an ROI of almost 20:1, double Visante's estimates







Employers Are Overwhelmingly Satisfied With Their PBMs



Methodology: The national survey was conducted online by North Star Opinion Research between June 4–9, 2020 consisting of 250 respondents drawn from a list of benefit managers and human resources directors who work for companies with 1,000 or more employees, have at least 1,000 individuals under coverage, and have an annual drug spend of over one-million dollars.



PBMs Create \$145 Billion In Value To Society Annually



PBMs perform services creating \$145B in value

EXAMPLES:

✓ Better drug utilization

S Faster drug development



A 7:1 return on investment

For every dollar that health plan sponsors invest in PBMs, seven dollars in value are returned to the healthcare system.



PBM services generate \$148B in savings annually

These savings are from PBM-negotiated rebates and discounts combined with lower expenditures on other health care services from increased drug utilization.

\$58B lost annually without PBMs




In a world without PBMs, employer health plan sponsors, insurers and others would pay much more if they had to act as their own pharmacy benefit managers. Without PBMs performing valuable services, 40% of the \$145 billion in value, or \$58 billion, would be lost annually.



Patient Savings and Independent Pharmacy Access in Michigan

PBMs are advocates for patients in the fight against high drug costs



Nationwide, the independent pharmacy marketplace is stable.4

In Michigan, between 2013 and 2023, the number of independent pharmacies grew from 926 to 1,097, an 18.5% increase.5

of business, but according to NCPDP data and the National Community Pharmacists Association (NCPA), the number of independent pharmacies has generally been stable. The NCPA found that in the last year, the number of independent pharmacies "was essentially flat," demonstrating a stable marketplace.⁶ Adam Fein's Drug Channels also found that the independent pharmacies' financials have also been steady. From 2016 to 2020, the average per prescription gross profit margin for independent pharmacies ranged from 20.8% to 21.1%, showing
