COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

The House Committee on Military, Veterans and Homeland Security was called to order by Chair Conlin.

SB 176	(Sen. Santana)	A bill to amend 1893 PA 206, entitled "The general property tax act," by amending section 7b (MCL 211.7b), as amended by 2013 PA 161.
SB 330	(Sen. Cavanagh)	A bill to amend 1893 PA 206, entitled "The general property tax act," (MCL 211.1 to 211.155) by adding section 7c.
SB 364	(Sen. Damoose)	A bill to amend 1893 PA 206, entitled "The general property tax act," by amending section 53b (MCL 211.53b), as amended by 2022 PA 141.
