COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Thursday, November 9, 2023 12:22 PM Room 327, House Office Building

The House Committee on Natural Resources, Environment, Tourism and Outdoor Recreation was called to order by Chair Pohutsky.

The Chair requested attendance be called:

Representative Paiz moved to adopt the meeting minutes from October 26, 2023. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid HB 4359 before the committee:

HB 4359 (Rep. Brabec)

A bill to repeal 2016 PA 389, entitled "An act to preempt local ordinances regulating the use, disposition, or sale of, prohibiting or restricting, or imposing any fee, charge, or tax on certain containers," (MCL 445.591 to 445.593).

Representative Brabec introduced an (H-1) substitute for HB 4359. Questions and discussion followed.

Representative Shannon moved to adopt substitute (H-1) to HB 4359. The motion prevailed 8-1-0:
