The House Committee on Tax Policy was called to order by Chair Neeley.

The Chair laid HB 4068 before the committee:

HB 4068 (Rep. Hood)

A bill to amend 1967 PA 281, entitled "Income tax act of 1967," (MCL 206.1 to 206.847) by adding section 253.

Representative Grant offered the following amendments to HB 4068:

- 1. Amend page 1, line 2, after "2023" by inserting "and subject to the applicable limitations in this section".
- 2. Amend page 2, line 1, after "section." by inserting "An individual taxpayer shall not claim a credit under this section for more than 6 verified blood donations in a single tax year.".
