## **COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

Wednesday, October 11, 2023 12:00 PM Room 521, House Office Building

The House Committee on Tax Policy was called to order by Chair Neeley.

The Chair requested attendance be called:

Representative VanWoerkom moved to adopt the meeting minutes from September 27, 2023. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid HB 4905 and HB 4906 before the committee:

HB 4905	(Rep. Farhat)	A bill to amend 1937 PA 94, entitled "Use tax act," by amending section 4cc (MCL 205.94cc), as added by 2015 PA 252.
HB 4906	(Rep. Andrews)	A bill to amend 1933 PA 167, entitled "General sales tax act," by amending section 4ee (MCL 205.54ee), as added by 2015 PA 251.
