The House Committee on Tax Policy was called to order by Chair Neeley.

Representative Farhat moved to adopt the meeting minutes from November 1, 2023. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid SB 175 before the committee:

SB 175 (Sen. Santana)

A bill to amend 1893 PA 206, entitled "The general property tax act," by amending section 27b (MCL 211.27b), as amended by 2012 PA 382.

Nick Cook, representing Senator Santana's Office, and Alvin Horhn, representing the City of Detroit, testified in support of SB 175. Questions and discussion followed.

Alan Fox, representing the Michigan Association of County Treasurers, testified in support of SB 175. Questions and discussion followed.

HB 4691 (Rep. Aiyash)

A bill to amend 1967 PA 281, entitled "Income tax act of 1967," (MCL 206.1 to 206.847) by adding section 280.

Jenan Jondy, representing the Michigan State University Economic Development Administration Center, testified in support of HB 4691. Questions and discussion followed.
