I write to you today on behalf of Navistar, Inc. regarding our support of Senate Bill 0501 which would increase weight limits in Michigan for electric trucks and bring the state into alignment with existing federal law.

Based in Lisle, Illinois, Navistar or its subsidiaries and affiliates produce International® brand commercial trucks and engines, IC Bus® brand school and commercial buses, all-makes OnCommand® Connection advanced connectivity services, and Fleetrte®, ReNEWeD® and Diamond Advantage® brand aftermarket parts.
