


- ➤ The State Budget Office, DTMB, has recommended GOCC for a \$7,300,000 (\$6,950,000 original request with increase being covered by the college) Capital Outlay project to the Joint Capital Outlay Subcommittee.
- ► This project will address many instructional and structural needs on the campus's north side including the library/learning commons, automotive-welding-electrical labs, business program classrooms, as well as, campus security needs, accessibility and safe egress issues, IT Infrastructure upgrades, art instructional studio, window and door replacement, and exterior wall replacement on E and F units.


- "Unit E includes teaching spaces for the technology laboratories (welding, electrical, and automotive) and is approximately 14,870 square feet."
 - The mechanical, electrical, and technology infrastructure within Unit E needs replacement to increase the serviceable life of the building. As these building systems are upgraded, the spaces will be returned to an appropriate finished state, meeting all current code requirements. The exterior facade will be upgraded to meet current energy code, as will the doors and windows.


- "Unit F includes the Library, various instructional classroom spaces, office spaces, and circulation space and is approximately 39,800 square feet."
 - ▶ The mechanical, electrical, and technology infrastructure within Unit E needs replacement to increase the serviceable life of the building. 























































Glen Oaks Campus Renovation Project Current Condition-E & F Walls...



Glen Oaks Campus Renovation Project

- Glen Oaks has received only one Capital Outlay project funding in 50 years.
- This was in 1999 for a \$3,200,00 project (\$1,600,000 from the State).
- Every other community college in MI that has asked for Capital Outlay funding has received at least one funded project since Glen Oaks did in 1999.
- ► The college must upgrade the facilities and address repairs if it is to remain a viable servant to the community in providing the missiondriven programming via state-of-the-art laboratories, classrooms, student support areas, athletic and extracurricular facilities, and community service spaces.
