



Number of Applicants, Admitted and Enrolled Students




<u>Tied for #1 Transfer Student destination</u> in Michigan for 2021, among the public institutions

Racial and Ethnic Diversity

- 16.2% underrepresented minority students (same as in fall 2020)
- Overall percentage of African American students rose to 12.3% (compared to 10% in fall 2020)
- 2.5% International transfer students enrolled in fall 2021 (compared to 2.3% in fall 2020)



Financial Profile

- 30.4% Pell-eligible (compared to 25.4% in fall 2020)
- 13% are receiving institutional, need-based financial aid (compared to 8% in fall 2019, 10% in fall 2020)
- 56.7% received our automatic, merit-based scholarships
- New addition: Frontline Workers Scholarship



- 2.5% of Transfers are international (compared to 2.3% in fall 2020)





Part-time vs. Full-time Students







Other Demographic Information

- 20.2% adult learners (over the age of 25)
 - most adult learners on campus are transfer students
- 34% of new transfers identify as first-generation college students (compared to 33.4% of FTIACs)
- 5.9% of new Transfers are living on campus (compared to 3.3% in fall 2020)

Recent Transfer/College Credit Changes



- No credit limit on transfer credit from community college or 4-Year institution
- Transfer credits accepted any time during attendance
- Enhanced acceptance of Advance Placement, International Baccalaureate, and College-Level Examination Program (CLEP)
- Adopted a policy for DANTES Subject Standardized Tests (DSST)
- New process created for Prior Learning Assessment (PLA)
- New OU policy accepts Ohio Transfer 36 from Ohio community colleges to satisfy OU general education requirements
- Expansion of Online Transfer Tool with nearly 103K transfer course equivalents for students to view

Average Credits Upon Graduation



- 3,236 students awarded an undergraduate degree
 Fall 2019 through Summer 2020
 - o 2,631 (81.3%) graduates had some transfer credit
 - Overall average transfer credit: 43.2 credits
 - 1,192 graduates with transfer credit were FTIACs
 - Average transfer credits for FTIACs is 20.9 credits
