TRANSFER OPPORTUNITY

52 percent of bachelor's degree earners in 2015-16 had previously enrolled at a community college.

Michigan's community colleges are the gateways to bachelor's degrees.



AFFORDABLE ACCESS

The average annual in-state tuition at community colleges is typically less than a third of the average university tuition.

Michigan's community colleges remain very affordable requiring far less borrowing/debt than university attendance.



LOCAL VALUE

70 percent of community college students stay in their communities after graduation.











Student Progression Through the Developmental Math Sequence²¹




Percentage of 2015-16 Bachelor's Degree Earners with Previous Enrollments at Two-Year Public Institutions



The states in the map represent the states in which bachelor's degrees were awarded. In this analysis, baccalaureate-granting institutions that predominantly award associate degrees (at least 55 percent of the undergraduate degrees awarded are associate degrees) are classified as two-year institutions. 


