

Historical Funding Model






Comparison of General Fund revenue sources FY1972 to FY2018 Sources: HEIDI and general fund budgets


State Appropriation vs Institutional Financial Aid





Equivalent State Funding per Degree




Total Headcount – Enrollment Charge Fall 2007- Fall 2017


Average Undergraduate Net Cost For Full-Time Resident Undergraduate Students

	FY2017
Tuition	\$ 12,923
Average Aid per Student *	(3,817)
Average Net Cost	\$ 9,106
Average Net Cost %	70.5%

Financial Aid can vary greatly from student to student, however, the average net tuition cost for a full-time resident undergraduate student was \$9,106 in FY2017, a 29.5% discount off the "sticker price", due to Financial Aid awards.

How Tuition and Appropriations are Spent at Oakland






Fourth Lowest Expenditures per Student




FY2017 General Fund Expenditures per FYES




