# HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS SUBCOMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY

# II. Overview of the FY 2018-19 Judiciary Budget Request

Justice Bridget Mary McCormack, Justice of the Michigan Supreme Court, appeared before the subcommittee to give an overview presentation on the state's judiciary system and the FY 2018-19 budget request.

She discussed the importance of measuring performance and adopting best practices to improve outcomes; the importance of reengineering courts to streamline operations, improve efficiency, and save money; and the importance of implementing new technology to increase and improve access.

In particular, she discussed problem solving courts, statewide e-filing, the Michigan Legal Help website and self-help centers, changes in judgeships, and videoconferencing. Discussion ensued (questions and answers).

#### III. Overview of the Court of Appeals

Judge Christopher M. Murray, Judge of the Michigan Court of Appeals, appeared before the subcommittee. He gave an overview presentation on the Court of Appeals. Primarily, he focused on the importance of timeliness and efficiency in the handling of court cases. Also, he discussed movement of the Court of Claims to the Court of Appeals. Discussion ensued (questions and answers).
