MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION & INFRASTRUCTURE

January 26, 2016

Chair Pettalia called the meeting to order.

Rep. Cochran moved to approve the minutes of the meeting held December 15, 2015. The motion prevailed.

Chair Pettalia laid before the committee SB 513 – Stamas – Highways; name; renaming a bridge on US-10; designate as the “Seaman Aaron D. Ullom Memorial Bridge”.

Chair Pettalia recognized Senator Stamas to introduce members of Seaman Aaron D. Ullom’s family and to testify in support of SB 513.

Chair Pettalia recognized Rep. Glenn who testified in support of SB 513.

Chair Pettalia recognized Debi & Kevin Ullom and Sean Bartley, Seaman Ullom family. Mr. Kevin Ullom explained to the Committee on Transportation & Infrastructure how his son was killed in Afghanistan.

Rep. Goike moved to report out SB 513 with the recommendation that it pass. The motion prevailed, the vote being 15-0-1.
