Minutes of the House Standing Committee
On
Tourism and Outdoor Recreation

Wednesday, November 30, 2016 11:00 a.m. Room 326 House Office Building

The House Standing Committee on Tourism and Outdoor Recreation was called to order by Representative Bruce Rendon, Chair.

The Chair announced Speaker Cotter's September 15, 2016 appointment of Representative Joel Johnson to the Committee on Tourism and Outdoor Recreation.

The Clerk called the roll; members present were **Representatives Rendon, Goike, Forlini, Johnson, Cole, Brinks, and Gay-Dagnogo. (7/8)**

Member absent and excused was **Representative Smiley. (1/8)**

The Clerk announced that a quorum was present.

The Chair laid before the committee the minutes of May 25, 2016 as printed.

The Chair laid before the committee Senate Bills 1073, 1074 and 1075.

SB 1073 (Meekhof) Natural resources; hunting; displaying base license with an electronic device; allow.

SB 1074 (Zorn) Natural resources; hunting; displaying waterfowl license with an electronic device; allow.

SB 1075 (Schmidt) Natural resources; fishing; displaying fishing license with an electronic device; allow.

Trevor VanDyke, Legislative Liaison and Policy Advisor for the Michigan Department of Natural Resources, testified in support of the bill.
