HOUSE STANDING COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY

Tuesday, December 5th 2018 7:12 p.m. Room 308 House Office Building

Representative Runestad, Chair, called the meeting to order.

Chair Runestad requested attendance be called to establish a quorum of the appointed committee members:

Present: Reps. Runestad, Theis, Howrylak, Cole, Hornberger, LaFave, Greimel, Guerra, and Sowerby.

Absent: Rep. Robinson.

Excused: Rep. Robinson.

Representative Theis moved to approve the minutes of the December 4th, 2018, meeting. The motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid HB 6252, HB 6572 and HB 6573 before the committee:

HB 6252 (Runestad) Health; death; suicide prevention commission; provide for.

HB 6572 (Runestad) Labor; fair employment practices; certain information related to employment records of a law enforcement employee; modify employer release.

HB 6573 (Runestad) Law enforcement; employment; law enforcement officer separation from service record act; modify to allow Michigan commission on law enforcement standards to obtain records.

Vice-Chair Theis assumed the gavel, the time being 7:13 p.m.

Chairman Runestad testified on the bills.

The Vice-Chair laid the committee at ease, the time being 7:17 p.m.

The Chair called the committee to order, the time being 7:18 p.m.

Sergeant Matt Williams, representing the Michigan State Police, and Renee Edmondson, representing the School Community Health Alliance of Michigan, submitted testimony cards in support of the bill, but did not wish to speak.

Representative Theis moved to adopt substitute (H-1) for HB 6252. The motion prevailed by a vote of 9-0-0.

Chairman Runestad offered the following amendments for HB 6252, as substitute (H-1):

1. Amend page 3, line 22, after "is" by striking out the balance of the line through "is" on line 23.

2. Amend page 3, line 24, after "Michigan" by striking out "Psychiatrist Association." and inserting "Psychiatric Society.".

Representative Theis moved to adopt the amendment for HB 6252, as substitute (H-1). The motion prevailed by a vote of 9-0-0.
