MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE
ON
LAW AND JUSTICE

Tuesday, May 2, 2017 9:00 a.m. Room 327 House Office Building

The House Standing Committee on Law and Justice was called to order by Chairman Kesto.

Representative Lucido moved to adopt the minutes of April 25, 2017. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

Chairman Kesto laid before the committee a presentation on Safe and Secure Rehabilitation.

John S. Cooper and Barbara R. Levine, representing the Citizens Alliance on Prisons and Public Spending (CAPPS), gave a presentation to the committee. Questions and discussion followed.

Vice-Chairman Lucido laid the following bills before the committee:

HB 4076 (Kesto) Criminal procedure; sentencing guidelines; sentencing guidelines for altering or tampering with data in an official report; enact.

HB 4289 (Phelps) Public employees and officers; ethics; crime of altering data used for official reports to intentionally falsify or mislead; create.

Chairman Kesto and Representative Phelps testified in support of the bills. Questions and discussion followed.
