**MINUTES OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE ON
TRANSPORTATION AND INFRASTRUCTURE**

Tuesday, February 6, 2018 10:30 a.m. Room 521 House Office Building, Lansing

Representative Cole, Chair, called the meeting to order.

Representative Howell made a motion to adopt the minutes from the meeting held on January 30, 2018. No objections being offered, the minutes were accepted as presented.

Representative Chirkun made a motion to excuse absent members. No objections being offered, absent members were excused.

The Chair laid the following bill before the Committee.

HB 4840 (Tedder) Traffic control; speed restrictions; school zone speed limits; apply to limited access highway segment with a pedestrian overhead walkway.

Representative Tedder reviewed the provisions of the bill with the Committee.

HB 4840 (H-1) was adopted by the Committee on November 28, 2017.

Representative Webber made a motion to report HB 4840 (H-1) with recommendation.

HB 4699 (H-1) was adopted by the Committee on January 30, 2018.

1. Amend page 2, line 7, after "SECTION" by striking out "225" and inserting "224".
