**MINUTES OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION AND
INFRASTRUCTURE**

Tuesday, February 21, 2017 10:30 a.m. Room 521 House Office Building, Lansing

Representative Cole, Chair, called the meeting to order.

The Committee Clerk read in the letter from Speaker Tom Leonard to Clerk of the House Gary Randall dated February 15, 2017 appointing Representative Terry Sabo as a committee member for the balance of the 2017-2018 legislative session.

A roll call was taken for the purpose of recording attendance.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Representatives Cole, Webber, Lucido, Maturen, Roberts, Howell, Alexander, Calley, Noble, Chirkun, Love, Clemente, Sabo, Sneller.

Representative Noble made a motion to adopt the minutes of the meeting held on February 14, 2017. No objections being offered, the minutes were accepted as presented.

Kirk Steudle, Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) Director, provided a presentation to the Committee and reviewed the following topics: a healthy economy relies on good highways; all transportation supports the economy; Michigan's multi-modal transportation system; multiple modes, varied oversight; when to call MDOT; Michigan's road network; measuring performance; 2017 performance excellence plan; saving money; Michigan is a pioneer in asset management; leaner and smarter; Michigan is a transportation leader and transportation innovator; automotive mobility innovation; national AV leader; local collaboration; MDOT 2016 year in review; where do we stand; MDOT state highway projected pavement condition; current investment (including new revenue); 2015 MDOT highway pavement condition by lane miles; MDOT pavement only program investment v. pavement condition; MDOT highway capital program investment; transportation funding and bonding; Michigan transportation fund; state revenue package; and state revenue package non-monetary provisions.

Chair Cole stated that the Committee would stand at ease, the time being 11:45 a.m.

The Chair reconvened the meeting at 11:46 a.m.

The Chair laid HB 4057 before the Committee.

HB 4057 (Leutheuser) Highways; name; portion of US-12 in the city of Jonesville; designate as the "James Bondsteel Memorial Highway".

Representative Webber made a motion to report HB 4057 with recommendation.
