**MINUTES OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE ON
TRANSPORTATION AND INFRASTRUCTURE**

Tuesday, March 7, 2017 10:30 a.m. Room 521 House Office Building, Lansing

Representative Cole, Chair, called the meeting to order.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Representatives Cole, Webber, Lucido, Maturen, Roberts, Howell, Alexander, Calley, Noble, Chirkun, Love, Clemente, Sabo, Sneller.

Representative Webber made a motion to adopt the minutes from the meeting held on February 28, 2017. No objections being offered, the minutes were accepted as presented.

The Chair laid the following bill before the Committee.

HB 4215 (Hughes) Traffic control; violations; unattended running vehicles; allow under certain circumstances.

The Chair stated that the Committee would stand at ease, the time being 10:32 a.m.

Chair Cole reconvened the meeting at 10:34 a.m.

Representative Hughes reviewed the provisions of HB 4215 with the Committee and answered questions.

Jon Taylor, of Marquette, Michigan, submitted a card for HB 4215 but did not indicate a position on the bill.

John LaMacchia, representing the Michigan Municipal League, offered a presentation which covered the following topics: Who makes up the League?; League Member Services; Local Government Budgeting; Local Government Revenue; Growth in Municipal General Revenue (2002-2012); Pillars for Strong Communities; Transportation and Infrastructure Priorities; Building Relationships; and The Big Picture.

Joanna Johnson, Managing Director, Road Commission of Kalamazoo County, was present to review the Asset Management Division. Ms. Johnson was joined by Roger Belknap, Michigan Transportation Asset Management Council (TAMC) Coordinator, Michigan Department of Transportation. Information related to the TAMC was presented and included : "The Home Rule

State”; PA 499; “An Honest Broker of Data”; TAMC dashboards; TAMC interactive map; 2014-2016 Achievements; Determine Core Elements; “The Top 125”; 2016 PASER Data Paved Federal-Aid Roads; 2015-2016 Paved Federal-Aid Road Condition; and 2007-2016 Paved Federal-Aid Road Condition. Discussion and questions followed.

There being no additional business before the Committee, Chair Cole declared the meeting adjourned, the time being 11:54 a.m.
