MINUTES OF THE HOUSE STANDING COMMITTEE

Representative Noble made a motion to adopt the minutes of the meeting held on September 25th, 2018. No objections being offered, the minutes were accepted as presented.

The Chair laid SB 1013 before the committee.

SB 1013 (Hildenbrand) Vehicles; registration plates; provision related to eligibility for fleet registration tax; modify.

Chair Cole explained the proposed substitute.

HB 6087 (Frederick)      Transportation; funds; state infrastructure bank; allow to municipalities to borrow money from.

HB 6088 (Howell)      Local government; bonds; loan from the state infrastructure bank; exempt from definition of municipal security under the revised municipal finance act.

Representative Frederick and Representative Howell testified in support of the bills.
