The House Standing Committee on Regulatory Reform was called to order by the Chair.

Representative Crawford moved to adopt the minutes of March 8, 2017. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

The Chair laid HB 4326 before the committee:

HB 4326 (Cole)      Environmental protection; permits; wastewater discharge permit fees; exempt licensed campgrounds.

Representative Cole testified in support of the bill. Dave Cordray, representing the Association of Recreational Vehicles and Campgrounds, joined Representative Cole in testifying in support of the bill. Questions and discussion followed.

Maggie Pallone, Deputy Director, and Rick Rusz, Chief for the groundwater permits unit, testified on behalf of the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality in opposition to the bill. Questions and discussion followed.
