MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE  
ON  
REGULATORY REFORM

Wednesday, June 6, 2018                      10:30 a.m.                      Room 519 House Office Building

The House Standing Committee on Regulatory Reform was called to order by the Chair.

Members present: Reps. Iden, Bellino, Kesto, Crawford, Theis, Webber, Griffin, Hauck, Hoytenga, Reilly, Moss, Dianda, Chirkun, Liberati, Love, Jones.

Absent/Excused: None.

The Chair welcomed his guest, two-time Olympic gold medalist for women's soccer Lindsay Tarpley, to the committee. Congratulations and applause followed.

The Chair laid HB 5376 before the committee:

HB 5376 (Iden)                      Construction; code; advisory committees for certain building codes; create.

Wayne Jewell, representing HuVACO and Green Oak Township, submitted a card in support of the bill, but was unable to testify due to time constraints.

Dan DeGraaf, representing the Michigan Concrete Association, submitted a card in support of the bill, but did not wish to speak.

Marnie Wills, Legislative Liaison for the Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, submitted a card in opposition to the bill, but did not wish to speak.

The Chair offered the following amendment to House Bill 5376 (H-1):

1. Amend page 9, following line 21, by inserting:  
**“(11) MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEES MAY PARTICIPATE IN MEETINGS OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE IN PERSON OR THROUGH USE OF ELECTRONIC OR TELEPHONIC MEANS AS DETERMINED BY THE DIRECTOR.”** and renumbering the remaining subsections.

Representative Dianda moved to adopt the amendment to House Bill 5376 (H-1). The motion prevailed 13-2-0.

Representative Love offered the following amendment to House Bill 5376 (H-1):

1. Amend page 9, line 3, after “**CODE.**” by inserting “**EACH ADVISORY COMMITTEE SHALL SUBMIT ITS REPORT TO THE DIRECTOR WITHIN 45 DAYS OF COMPLETION OF ITS DELIBERATIONS OF PROPOSED REVISIONS OR AMENDMENTS.**”.

Representative Love spoke to her amendment.

Representative Love moved to adopt the amendment to House Bill 5376 (H-1). The motion prevailed 16-0-0.

“**(xi) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF A UNION.**” and renumbering the remaining subparagraph.
2. Amend page 5, following line 1, by inserting:  
“**(viii) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF A UNION.**” and renumbering the remaining subparagraph.
3. Amend page 5, following line 20, by inserting:  
“**(xiii) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF A UNION.**” and renumbering the remaining subparagraph.
4. Amend page 6, following line 11, by inserting:  
“**(xi) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF A UNION.**” and renumbering the remaining subparagraph.
5. Amend page 6, following line 22, by inserting:  
“**(vi) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF A UNION.**” and renumbering the remaining subparagraph.
6. Amend page 7, following line 7, by inserting:  
“**(vi) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF A UNION.**” and renumbering the remaining subparagraph.
7. Amend page 8, following line 3, by inserting:  
“**(xv) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF A UNION.**” and renumbering the remaining subparagraph.

Representative Love spoke to her amendments.

Representative Love moved to adopt the amendments to House Bill 5376 (H-1). The motion failed 6-10-0.

Representative Webber moved to report House Bill 5376 with recommendation as amended as substitute (H-2). The motion prevailed 9-5-2.

The Chair laid SB 969 before the committee:

SB 969 (Jones)                      Liquor; other; use, possession, and sale of marijuana-infused alcohol; prohibit.

Spencer Nevins and Brett Visner, representing the Michigan Beer and Wine Wholesalers Association testified in support of the bill. Questions and discussion followed.

Scott Ellis, representing the Michigan Licensed Beverage Association, submitted a card in support of the bill but did not wish to speak.

Kerry Krone and Julie Wendt, representing the Michigan Liquor Control Commission, submitted a card indicating that the commission has no position on the bill and did not wish to speak.

Representative Hauck moved to adopt the minutes of May 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2018. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

There being no further business before the committee, the Chair adjourned the meeting at 11:01 a.m.
