
The fiscal information in this background briefing is based on data through January 1, 2010.

The General Government appropriations bill includes budgets for the following departments and agencies:

- Attorney General
- Civil Rights
- Executive Office
- Information Technology
- Legislature
- Legislative Auditor General
- Management and Budget (includes Civil Service Commission)
- State
- Treasury (includes Bureau of State Lottery, Michigan Gaming Control Board, and Michigan Strategic Fund)


General Government Budget: Gross Appropriations


General Government Share of State GF/GP

General Government GF/GP by Department


FY 2009-10 GF/GP = \$625,194,200
