
General Government Budget

The General Government appropriations bill includes budgets for the following departments and agencies:

- Attorney General
- Civil Rights
- Executive Office
- Legislature
- Legislative Auditor General
- State
- Technology, Management, and Budget (includes Civil Service Commission and Information Technology)
- Treasury (includes Bureau of State Lottery, Michigan Gaming Control Board, Michigan Strategic Fund, and Michigan State Housing Development Authority)

General Government: Gross Appropriations


Appropriations for State Building Authority rent and Michigan Strategic Fund (MSF) included in FY 2006; appropriations for MSF not included in FY 2007; appropriations for MSF included in FY 2008 and on; appropriations for Michigan State Housing Development Authority included in FY 2011; one-time appropriations totaling \$166.3 million and appropriations for workforce investment/development included in FY 2012.

General Government makes up 10.0% of the total state GF/GP budget


FY 2011-12 GF/GP Total = \$8,626,998,900

General Government Funding Sources


FY 2011-12 General Government Budget = \$4,064,387,000



DEPARTMENT APPROPRIATIONS


General Government Gross by Department
