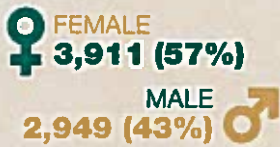

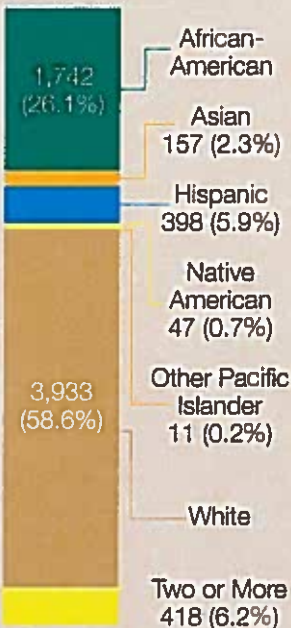

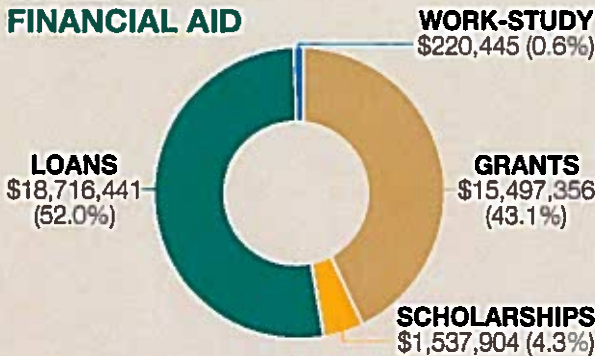
GENDER*



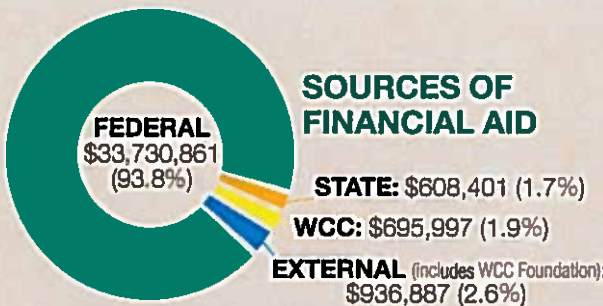
ETHNICITY*

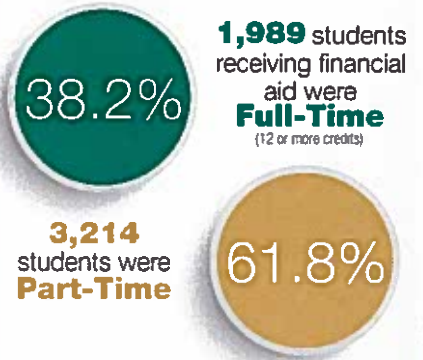

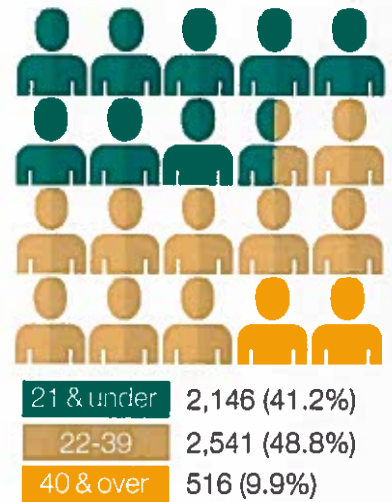
