HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS SUBCOMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY

The subcommittee meeting was called to order by Representative VerHeulen at 12:00 p.m.

I. Approval of the Minutes from the Previous Subcommittee Meeting

A motion was moved by Representative Miller to approve the minutes from the subcommittee meeting held on March 8, 2017. The motion prevailed, a majority of the members voting in the affirmative.

II. House Substitute for HB 4233 (H-1) Draft 1

- A. Representative Brann moved to adopt the House Substitute for HB 4233 (H-1) Draft 1. The motion prevailed, a majority of the members voting in the affirmative. Yeas (4) - Representatives VerHeulen, Brann, Miller, and Pagan. Nays (0). Passes (0).
- B. Robin Risko from the House Fiscal Agency proceeded to give an overview of the contents of the bill. She highlighted appropriations as compared to the current year budget and the Executive recommendation. The House Subcommittee Chairman's recommendation is \$299.4 million Gross, \$191.9 million GF/GP. The budget is \$1.1 million Gross, \$2.7 million GF/GP over current year appropriated levels and \$580,900 Gross, \$500,000 GF/GP under the Executive recommendation. She highlighted the new boilerplate section added by the Chair. Discussion ensued.
- C. Representative Miller moved to report the House Substitute for HB 4233 (H-1) Draft 1 out of the House subcommittee and refer it to the House Standing Committee on Appropriations with recommendation that it pass. The motion prevailed, a majority of the members voting in the affirmative. Yeas (4) – Representatives VerHeulen, Brann, Miller, and Pagan. Nays (0). Passes (0).
