BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2020-116 LR would make numerous amendments to rules pertaining to physician's assistants and the profession. The rule set would clarify definitions and other existing rules, adopt updated educational standards, incorporate legislative changes for licensure by endorsement, and revise requirements for the verification of licenses held in other jurisdictions.
