

Employment in Michigan


Michigan employers added approximately **14,600 jobs** (total nonfarm) in February 2023, which was the largest monthly gain since April 2022.

Unemployment Rate


The Michigan **unemployment rate** remained at **4.3%** in February. Approximately 8,100 additional people reported being employed and the labor force grew by just over 6,200 people.

Pandemic Jobs Rebound


Michigan has added back just over 1.0 million jobs from the pandemic low point in April 2020, but is still approximately **33,100**, or **0.7%**, below the pre-pandemic level in February 2020.
