

#### **Employment in Michigan**


Michigan employers added approximately **100 jobs** (total nonfarm) in July 2023, which was the lowest monthly gain since March 2023, but it was the ninth straight month with job gains.


# **Unemployment Rate**

The Michigan **unemployment rate** remained at **3.6%** in July 2023, maintaining its lowest level since May 2000. Approximately 22,000 additional people reported being employed and the labor force grew by 22,900 workers.

# Pandemic Jobs Rebound




Michigan has added back just under 1.05 million jobs from the pandemic low point in April 2020, but is still approximately **10,300, or 0.2%, below** the pre-pandemic level in February 2020.
