## **COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

Tuesday, April 25, 2023

The House Appropriations Subcommittee on General Government was called to order by Chair Brabec.

The Chair requested attendance be called:

Present: Reps. Brabec, Hood, Puri, O'Neal, Steckloff, Mentzer, Bollin, Lightner, Kuhn.

Absent: None. Excused: None.

Representative Puri moved to adopt the meeting minutes from March 21, 2023. There being no objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous consent.

Representative Hood moved to place the House Substitute for HB 4292 (H-1) before the House Subcommittee for discussion. The motion passed. Yeas (8) – Representatives Brabec, Hood, Puri, O'Neal, Steckloff, Mentzer, Bollin, and Lightner; Nays (0); Abstain (1) - Representative Kuhn.

Rep. Brabec called on Viola Wild and Michael Cnossen, Fiscal Analysts from the House Fiscal Agency, to provide highlights of the House Subcommittee Chair recommended FY 2023-24 General Government budget and to answer members' questions.

Rep. Bollin moved to restore deleted general boilerplate sections. The motion failed. Yeas (3) - Representatives Bollin, Lightner, and Kuhn; Nays (6) - Representatives Brabec, Hood, Puri, O'Neal, Steckloff, and Mentzer.

Rep. Bollin moved to retain current year contingency authorizations for all departments. The motion failed. Yeas (3) - Representatives Bollin, Lightner, and Kuhn; Nays (6) - Representatives Brabec, Hood, Puri, O'Neal, Steckloff, and Mentzer.

Rep. Bollin moved to include a \$100 placeholder and boilerplate in Treasury to provide for future funding for costs associated with early voting as required under Proposal 22-2. The motion failed. Yeas (3) - Representatives Bollin, Lightner, and Kuhn; Nays (0); Abstains (6) - Representatives Brabec, Hood, Puri, O'Neal, Steckloff, and Mentzer.

Representative O'Neal moved to refer House Bill No. 4292 (H-1) to the Committee on Appropriations. The motion prevailed 6-0-3:
