Michigan needs to invest in need-based financial aid for students.

Michigan ranks 40th among all states in terms of how much we invest in student financial aid. To become a Top 10 state in student financial aid investment, we need to invest another \$400 million in student scholarships and grants. Michigan should create a simplified, comprehensive, need-based student financial aid program.

Michigan should assist adult workers in earning a postsecondary credential in a high-demand field.

There are over 1 million working-aged adults in Michigan who already have some college under their belt but don't have a degree or certificate.
