# **Regulated Facilities:**

- **Consumer Fireworks:** Permanent and temporary structures
- Health Care: Hospitals, nursing homes (including veteran's homes),
  hospice residences, homes for the aged (HFA), adult foster care (AFC)
  facilities and ambulatory surgical centers/freestanding surgical
  outpatient facilities (ASC/FSOF)
- Penal Institutions: Prisons and jails
- **Schools:** Public, private and charter schools; colleges, universities and dormitories
- State Facilities: all
- Storage Tanks: aboveground and underground tanks




# **Services Provided:**

- Plan reviews for state-regulated facilities
- Inspections of state-regulated facilities
- Public education and enforcement
- Establish training standards for Michigan fire fighters
- Certify training programs for fire inspectors
- Administration of the National Fire Incident Reporting System (NFIRS)
- Administer the Fire Fighters Training Council and State Fire Safety Board activities
- Statewide coordination of fire fighter response to state declared disasters







# **Consumer Fireworks:**

- Total Certificates Issued in FY16: 930
  - Permanent Facilities: 244
  - Temporary Facilities: 686

- Total Low-impact Registrations in FY16: 2,081
  - Permanent Facilities: 1,290
  - Temporary Facilities: 791



# **Consumer Fireworks:**

- Certification fees funds LARA's fireworks operations
- 6% Sales Tax funds expenditures via sales tax formula
- 6% Fireworks Sales funds local's firefighter training
- A total of 49 citations were issued in FY16 for illegal sales and/or NFPA violations
