

- Federal Certification of Providers and Suppliers on Behalf of the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS)
- Workforce Background Checks
- Nurse Aide Training Program/Nurse Aide Registry (February 1, 2016)

# BCHS Overview

- Approximately 429 Employees
- 22 Office Locations with Main Offices in Lansing, Detroit, Grand Rapids and Gaylord
- Staffing includes Master's prepared social workers, nurses, sanitarians, dietitians, nutritionists, pharmacists, etc.

# BCHS Budget Overview

- \$61.1 Million Annual Budget
  - \$21.5 Million for Federal Certification
  - \$16.6 Million for Child Care
  - \$14.4 Million for Adult Foster, HFA and Camps
  - \$ 8.6 Million for State Licensing and Support
- Funding
  - \$19.1 Million in GF/GP
  - \$16.6 Million from MDE/Federal Grant
  - \$12.3 Million from Medicare/CMS
  - \$ 9.2 Million from Medicaid
  - \$ 3.9 Million in Licensing Fees
