

Access Health: A Scalable Model for Economic Growth and Economic Revitalization



As national efforts focus on economic revitalization, local models that reduce safety-net reliance and expand workforce participation are critical. Our community-based approach transitions individuals from programs like Medicaid and SNAP to employer-sponsored coverage, generating measurable economic impact and reducing public costs.

All tax calculations presented are based on 2025 federal and state tax rates, including IRS-published marginal brackets, Michigan's 2025 state income tax guidelines, and the FICA contribution rates established by the Social Security Administration.

Estimated Economic Impact

Each time one individual transitions from public assistance (SNAP and Healthy Michigan Medicaid) into full-time employment earning \$45,000 annually, the government sees a net positive impact of \$22,470 per year—through reduced public benefit costs and increased economic activity.
