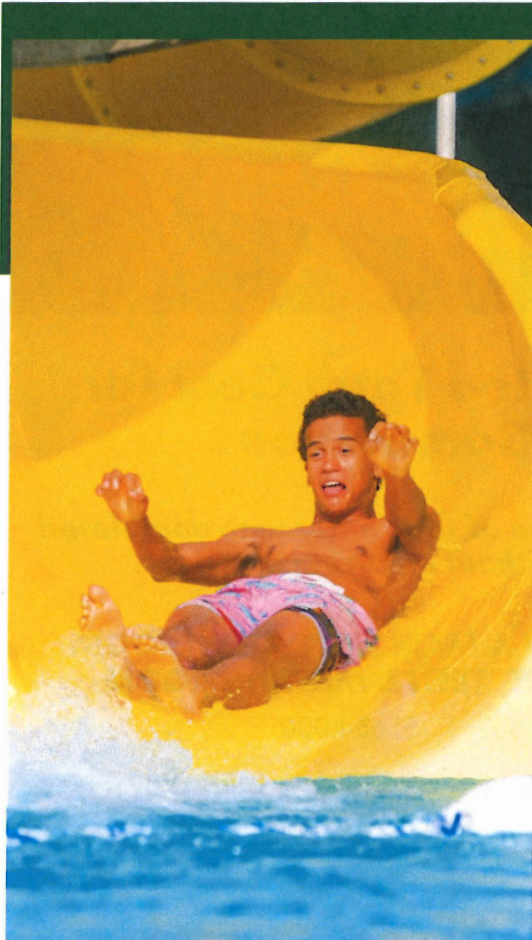


Progress to Date

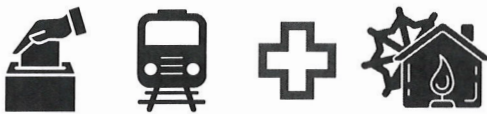


Zone A: *Opened June 2nd!*

The 50+ Wing, Childcare, and Lobby Restrooms are now complete, marking a major milestone in our project. Construction teams have created a welcoming and functional environment, with durable and visually appealing flooring throughout. All 50+ clubs and classes have officially moved into the new space, and the area is already bustling with activity. The only remaining work is the new, separate front entry for the 50+ Wing, which includes an Art Room, Multipurpose Room, and Wellness Room, currently being finalized to enhance accessibility and ease of navigation.

Zone B: *Expected to Open August!*

This area features administrative offices, a maintenance garage, four multipurpose rooms, and a single-stall restroom. The rooms are now complete, with the exception of flooring in the upstairs multipurpose rooms, which is the next step in construction. Meanwhile, new windows have been installed throughout Zone B, including the second-floor multipurpose rooms and the track, bringing in more natural light and improving ventilation. Once flooring is installed upstairs, the project will be complete and ready for fitness classes to take over!

Restroom Core, Teen Room, & Meeting Room

- Restroom Core: Enhancing accessibility and comfort with modern facilities that cater to diverse community needs.
- Teen Room: Creating a vibrant space equipped with state-of-the-art technology and versatile furniture to foster creativity and community engagement among our youth, giving us the opportunity to partner with local non-profits and community groups, proving a safe space for our youth which currently doesn't exist.
- Meeting Room: Upgrading infrastructure to accommodate larger groups, integrating multimedia capabilities for enhanced presentations and collaborative activities and community-based special events.

Women's & Family Locker Rooms

- Women's Locker Room: Revitalizing the facility to promote wellness and accessibility, featuring upgraded showers, changing areas, and amenities tailored to the needs of women in our community.
- Family Locker Rooms: Establishing a welcoming environment for families with private changing spaces, enhancing accessibility for caregivers, and ensuring a safe, supportive atmosphere for all members.

Community centers are vital hubs where people of all ages and backgrounds can come together to connect, grow, and thrive. They foster a strong sense of belonging, reduce isolation through social engagement, and offer opportunities to build meaningful relationships. With programs that promote physical and mental well-being—like fitness classes, educational workshops, and recreational activities—community centers support holistic health. Beyond everyday enrichment, they also serve critical roles in times of need, acting as **warming centers, crisis response sites, and early voting precincts**. As inclusive and adaptable spaces, community centers truly meet the diverse and evolving needs of the communities they serve.
