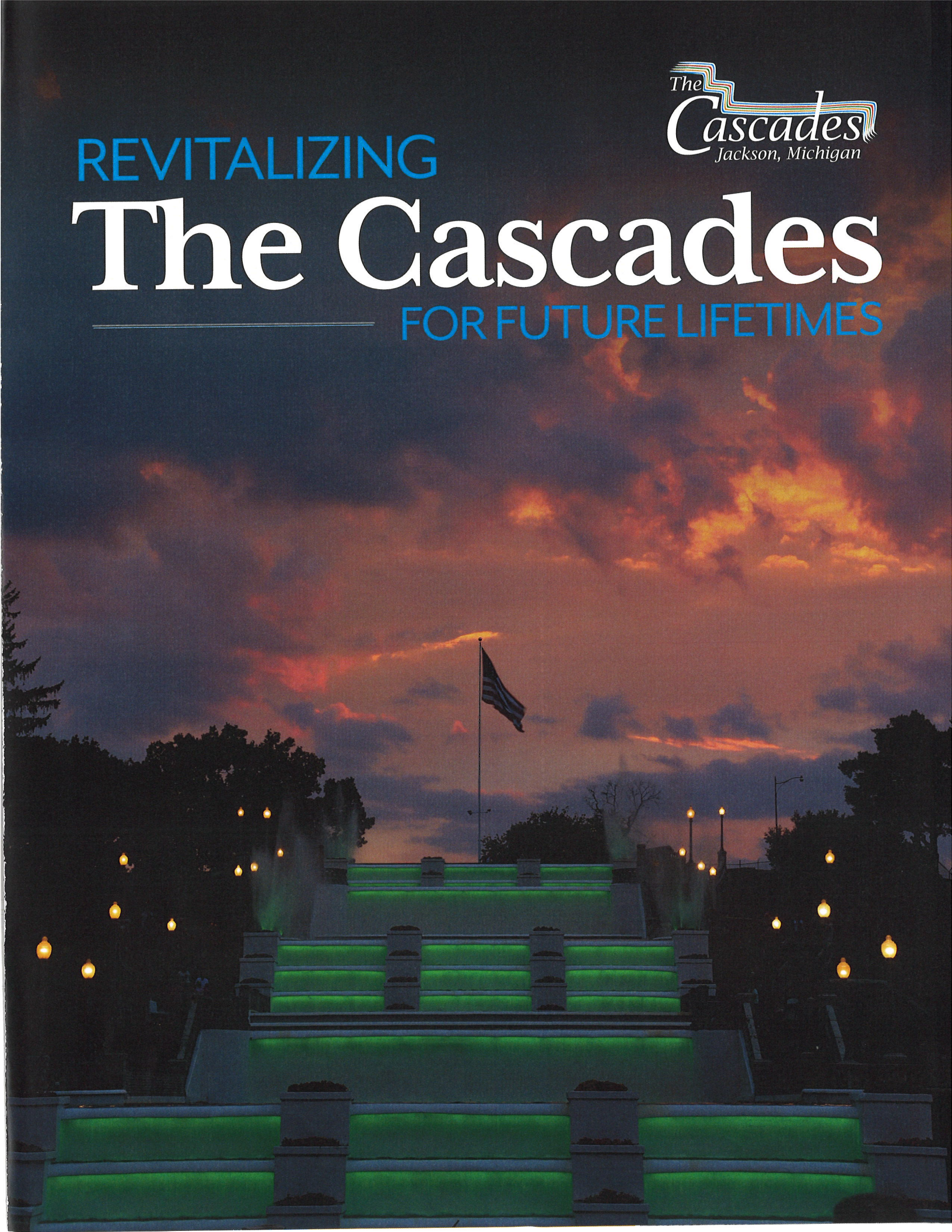

RESTORING Jackson's ICONIC Cascade Falls

Since 1970, the Jackson County Parks Department has been providing maintenance and updating Cascade Falls, a staple landmark in Jackson County, to ensure its continual operation. Built in the 1930s, Cascade Falls is a monument of beauty and distinction that has provided enjoyment and fond memories to millions for over 95 years. However, we now face maintenance issues that require \$3.5 million to preserve its legacy for another 100 years. \$1.8 million has been committed from local champions to help restore the concrete and pump room. We need your help to preserve this cherished legacy for future generations.

CONCRETE RESTORATION \$2 Million

Concrete elements have crumbled with age and the weight of 92 Michigan winters – flower beds, pool floors, spindles, columns, and stairs. All of which will need a combination of repairs or replacements. The complexity and size of these repairs necessitates that they all be done as one job.

NEW PUMP ROOM \$1.5 Million

The 1930's pump room is located underground, creating a damp environment, which is less conducive to the longevity of the equipment. The pump room will be transitioned above ground and include new pumps and piping.

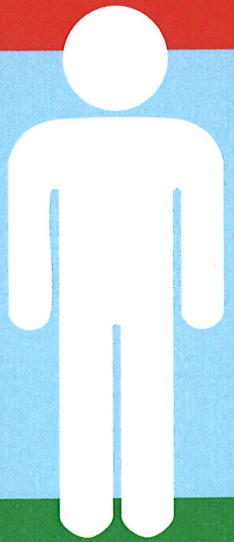

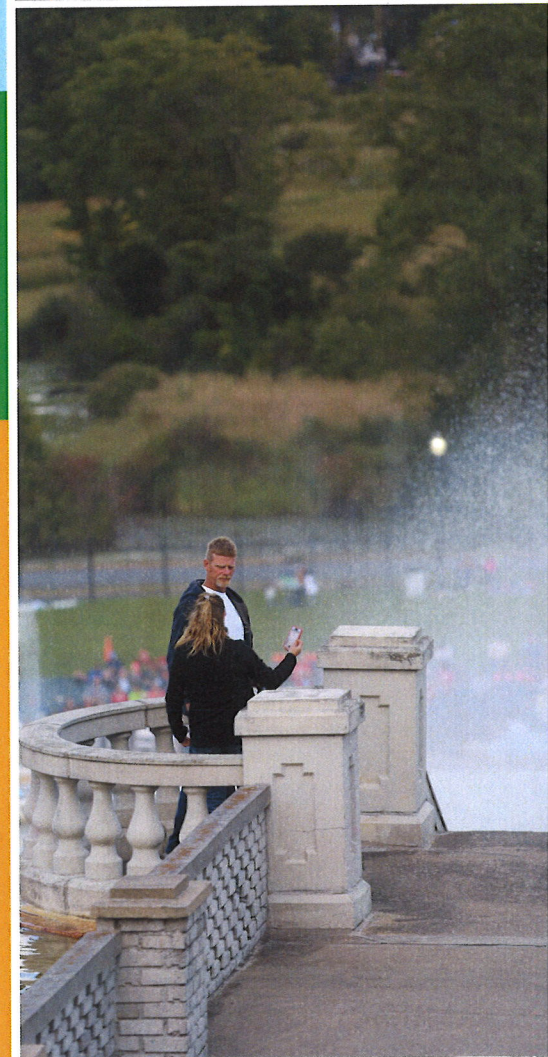
