Notes:

- Executive Orders 2023-6 and 2024-2 created the Department of Lifelong Education, Advancement, and Potential (MiLEAP), which combined offices from the Department of Civil Rights, the Department of Education, the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, the Department of Labor and Economic Opportunity, and the Department of Treasury. FY 2023-24 did not consolidate funding sources for the different components of MiLEAP from their original budget areas. FY 2023-24 reflects appropriations made in 2023 PA 321, which provided partial year funding for MiLEAP administrative costs.
- FY 2024-25 includes supplemental appropriations made in 2025 PA 22.
