



Educator Reach Highlights

Project Window: Sept. 2016-February 2020

Early Literacy Professional Learning Coaching Grant Allocation: 1 Million

The following are professional learning opportunities that were intentionally designed, with attention to research and adult learning principles, as an investment in Michigan's literacy educators to build capacity and have impact on student achievement.

- As of September 2019, over **700 coaches, administrators, and teacher leaders** participated in four days of initial professional development led by researchers in the *Essential Instructional Practices in Early Literacy: Grades K-3*.
- As of Feb. 3, 2020, **2,456 educators** have engaged in the Literacy Coaching Modules.
- As of February 2020, 15 Literacy Coaching Intensives have been facilitated across Michigan
- As of June 2019, **300 educator teams** attended the two day *Essential Instructional Practices in Literacy: Grades K-3 Team Institute*.
- As of Jan. 2020: Over **19,400 educators** have enrolled in the *Essential Instructional Practices in Early Literacy: Grades PreK & K-3 Modules*.
- As of Feb. 3, 2020 **725 educators** have engaged in the Classroom Library Modules.
- As of January 2020, 160 educators from Intermediate School Districts and Regional Educational Service Agencies have been trained in the Administrator Trainer of Trainer (ToT) Series for the *Essential Schoolwide and Centerwide Practices in Literacy*.
- To date, 270 preschool trainers have participated in the ToT on the *Essential Instructional Practices in Early Literacy: Pre Kindergarten*.
