MINUTES

HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS SUBCOMMITTEE ON Transportation DATE: March 2, 2022

Chairman VanSingel called the meeting to order at 12:00 PM.

Representatives VanSingel, Borton, Allor, Brann, Lightner, Steckloff, and Sabo were present.

Rep. Borton moved to adopt the minutes of the February 16, 2022 subcommittee meeting. The motion was approved by voice vote without objection.

The subcommittee heard a presentation from the **House Fiscal Agency**. The HFA analyst presented two documents that summarized the Governor's proposed FY 2022-23 Transportation Budget – one version that broke out the changes by fund source and one that broke out the changes by program area. HFA also provided several background and supporting documents.

Copies of the HFA documents are included in the official House Fiscal Agency minutes and are posted to the HFA website.]

Subcommittee members asked about the department's bond program, federal-aid to Michigan under the federal reauthorization (IIJA), support for requested increases in staffing/FTEs, weather stations replacement, the pumphouse generator project, and the new IIJA airport infrastructure grant program.
