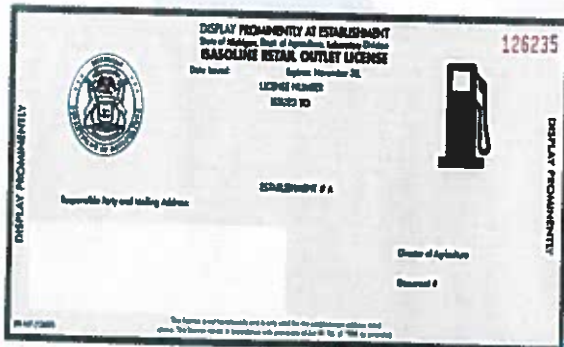

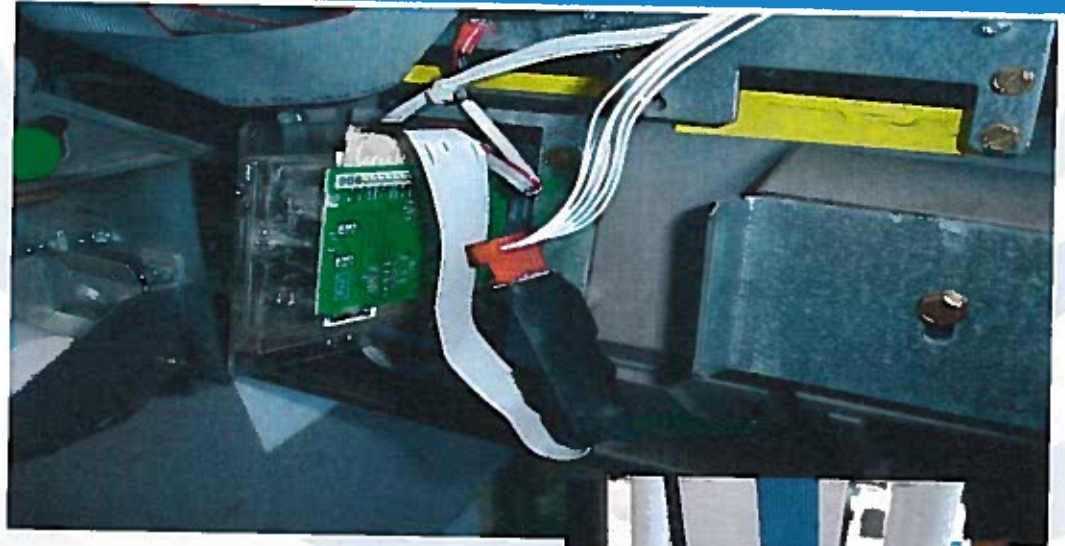
Why MDARD

– P.A. 283 of 1964



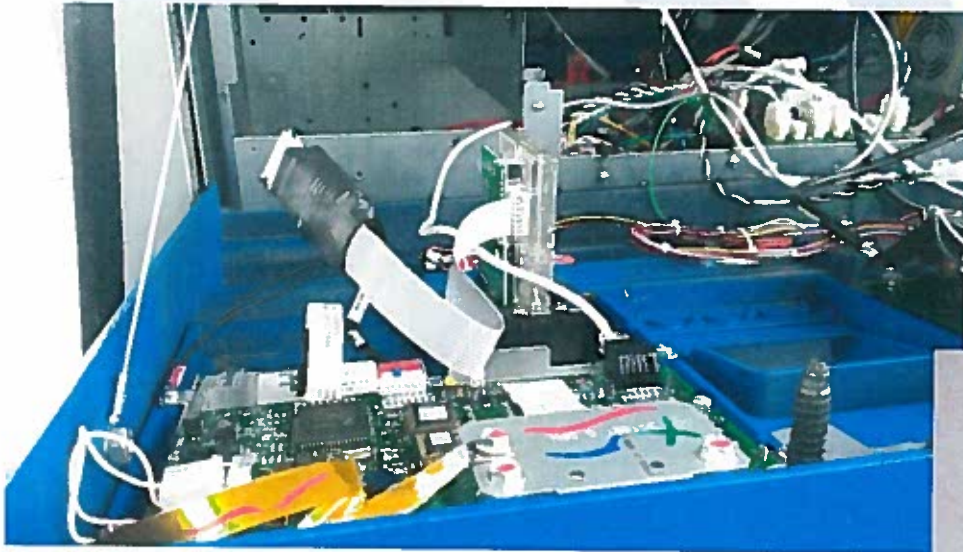


Skimmer Examples

Business Safeguards

- **Change Dispenser Locks**
 - Many use a common key
- **Add Dispenser Locks**
 - Some only require a star bit to open
- **Use Security Seals/Tape**
 - Place in correct location
 - Monitor
- **Keep Vigilant**



Business Actions if Found

- **Maintain control of device**
 - “Bag” pump
 - Do not touch or remove, if possible
- **Notify MDARD Weights and Measures**
- **Weekends**
 - Notify local law enforcement
 - Call Weights & Measures, leave details



Customer Safeguards

- Use “interior” pumps
 - These are the ones with direct line of sight to cashier
- Look for security seals/tape
 - While not all have this, if they do, check to see that it is intact
- **Monitor credit card statements often**
